LANG 5101 Basic Chinese for International Management

1. Course Information: LANG 5101 is a three-credit, a one-semester course designed for students in the MSc in International Management program with no previous knowledge of Chinese. The course aims to offer them a foundation in language so that they can communicate effectively and appropriately. The learning activities are mainly focused on developing students' listening and speaking skills to build up their confidence in using Putonghua for daily communication. Some reading of high frequency Chinese characters is integrated into the learning activities.
