1. Course Information: LANG1118 is a Chinese communication common core course, which is offered in Fall and Spring semesters. The course mainly targets at students who possess an advanced level of mastery in both Putonghua and standard written Chinese and helps them to develop advanced-level communication skills.

The course adopts a task-based instructional design providing all-round coverage of the four skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. It focuses on cultivating students' personalized and creative style to express themselves. In the meanwhile, the course also pays attention to the training of thinking and the practice of communication skills.
