

Guidelines for Chinese Course Selection (for Chinese language background students)

1. Read the information in the table below carefully, pay extra attention to the pre-requisites (if any) of the courses, and make an initial course choice that you think best suits you.
2. Click the course code to visit the corresponding webpage. If you have any questions, please consult the [course coordinator](#).
3. Register for the chosen course on the Student Information System (SIS).
4. Take classes as scheduled. Seek the class instructor's advice if needed.
5. Complete the Chinese course selection process before the end of the add/drop period.

LANG1421 Chinese Communication in the Digital Era	For students with Level 3 in HKDSE Chinese or above, a Chinese qualification in the Mainland <i>Gaokao</i> (or the Mainland JEE, PRC) or GSAT, or its equivalence (e.g. students with a high grade in the Chinese subject of GCE AL, IB AH, or IB AS)

LANG1416 C/P Effective Chinese Communication	For students with Level 3 in HKDSE Chinese or its equivalence. If your HKDSE Chinese Language result is below Level 3 or its equivalence: • JUPAS students admitted in 2023–24 or later will be automatically enrolled in LANG 1416P in their first semester. • Other students not meeting the requirement of DSE Level 3 and cannot find a suitable alternative course may apply for a requisite waiver through SIS before enrollment. Supporting information or an interview may be required.
LANG1416 I Effective Chinese Communication	This course cannot be registered directly. First complete the online form for Chinese course selection, then request “Instructor Consent” on the SIS. Attend classes as scheduled; confirmation is made by the instructor after you attend the first class. For students whose Chinese proficiency falls between the LANG1515 and 1416C/P, including those with international Chinese language qualifications or other Chinese-learning backgrounds who do not have HKDSE Chinese Language results.
